Conference Venue

The 2019 Annual Federal Conference will take place at Adelaide Oval, in the Ian McLachlan Room West, commencing at 9.00am Wednesday 31 July. Adelaide Oval is 16 minutes from Adelaide Airport, in the city centre. The Oval is a short 5 to 10 minutes' walk from North Terrace accommodation venues over a footbridge.

Workshop

Federal Council will hold a Conference Procedures Workshop on Tuesday 30 July from 5.15pm until 6.00pm, at the Adelaide Oval. The workshop is free and open to new delegates and others who wish to refresh their meeting procedures.
